

FINSBURY GEAR OPERATED ROLLER BLINDS



Gear operation is an efficient means of operating a roller blind for a smooth even operation. Controlled drive eliminates any problems with mishandled cords or chains.

Finsbury blinds are ideally suited to larger windows in areas such as schools, hospitals and open plan offices where heavier use can be expected.

They are operated with a cranked rod that drives through a heavy duty gearbox that is attached to the end of the roller.

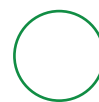
The rod can be detachable which is very useful in public areas to prevent unauthorised use or it can be permanently fixed to the gearbox drive.

It is especially appropriate in areas such as high level windows where cord or chain control would not be practical.

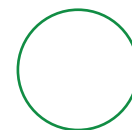
There are three sizes of roller tube enabling sizes up to 4.5m wide and 4m drop offering a practical solution to very large windows.

For areas where young children have access Finsbury gear operated roller blinds are inherently child safe as they do not have operating cords.

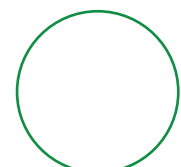
There are three sizes of roller tube enabling sizes up to 4.5m wide and a 4m drop offering a practical solution to very large windows.
